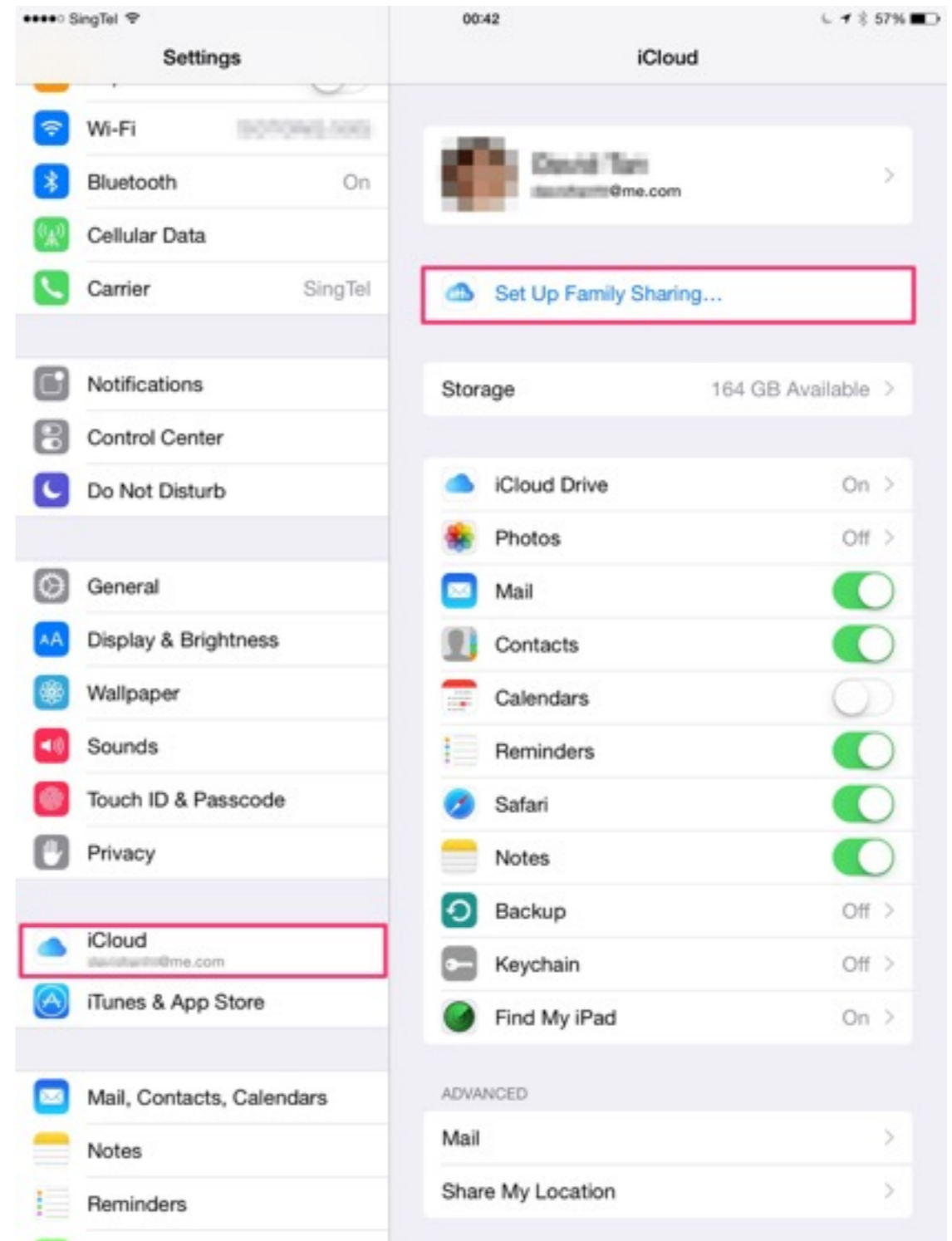


Family Sharing

- Allows up to six family members to share each other's purchases from iTunes Store without sharing accounts.
- Requires iOS 8 and above
- Family organiser needs to add credit card into Apple ID account
- Child needs to get approval from Family organiser before purchasing apps

- Go to Settings
- Tap on iCloud
- Verify correct iCloud Account is signed in
- Tap on “Set Up Family Sharing”

- In case your child forgets the password, these will be used by parents to verify and recover the password

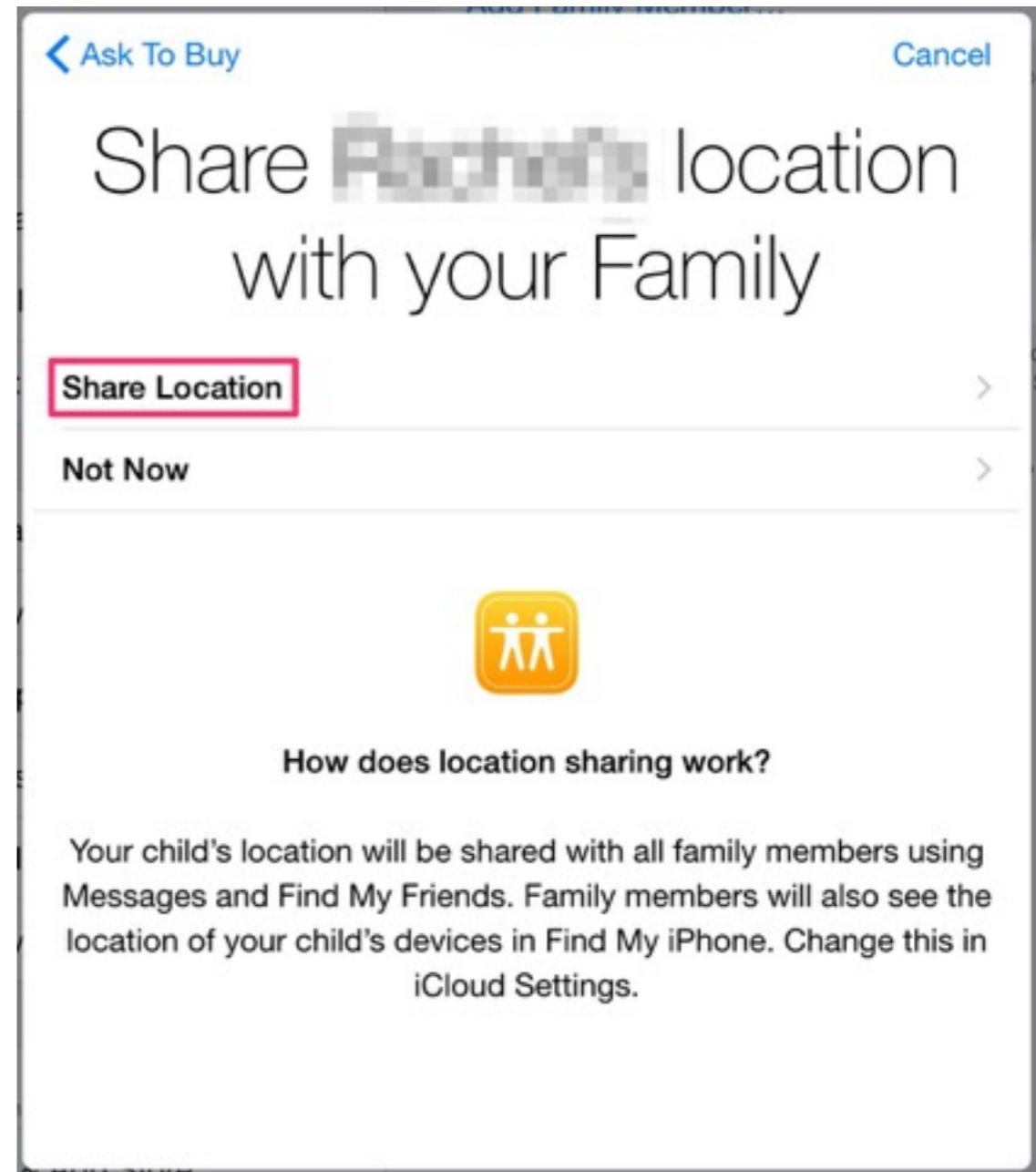

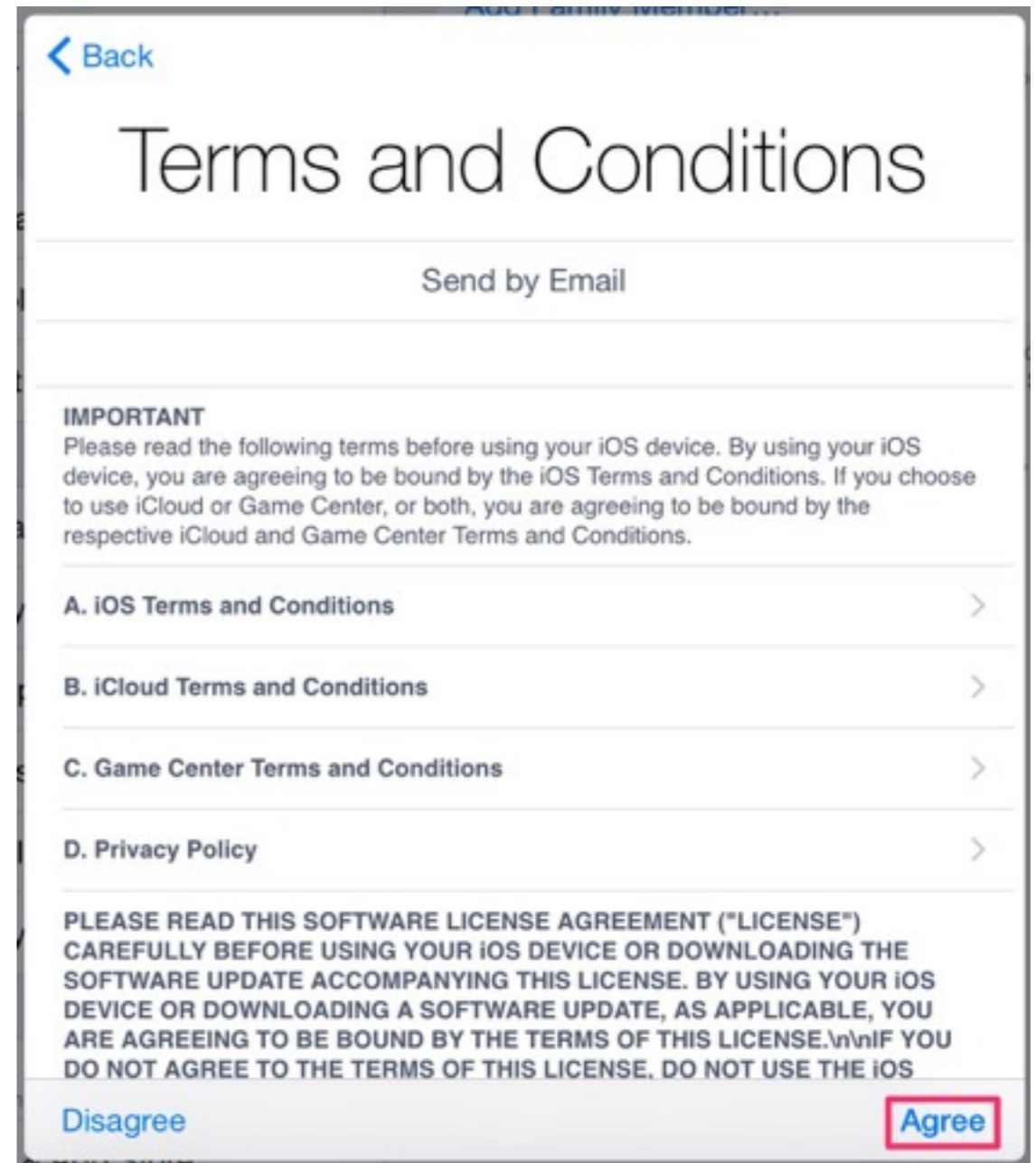

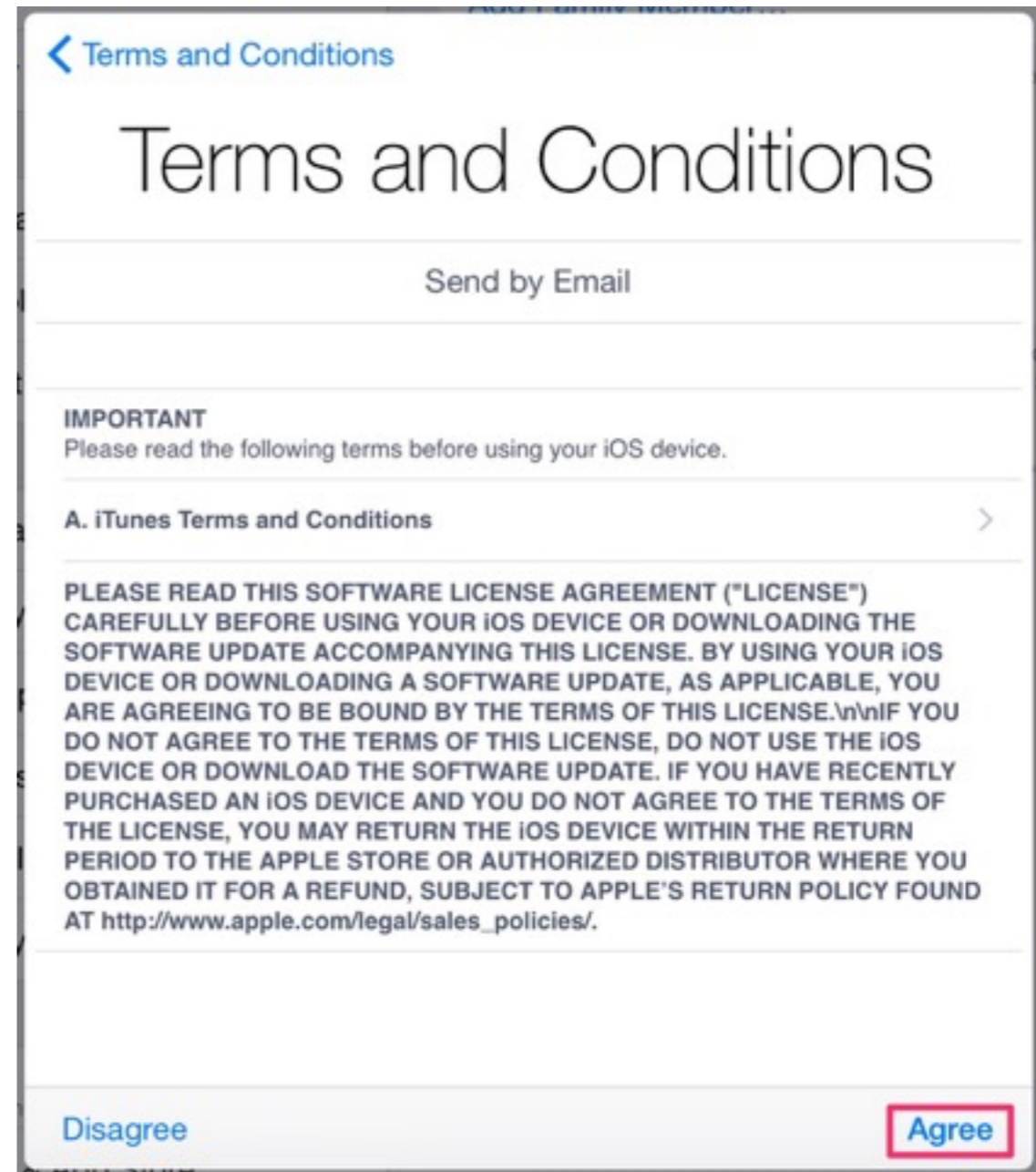
